I refer to our letter of 22 May 2008 enclosing a copy of the “note of matters agreed at or arising from pre-inquiry meeting on 13 May 2008”.

I enclose, for reference purposes, an additional copy of the note and would draw your attention to the following matters.


Firstly, as referred to in paragraph 3 of the note, a third reporter has now been appointed. He is Mr M Cunliffe BSc(Hons) MSc MCIWEM.

Secondly, as referred to in paragraph 4 of the note, I have now received further information about those parties who have indicated the intention of presenting oral evidence to the inquiry and attach a revised appendix setting out the current position.

Thirdly, as referred to in paragraph 13 of the note, the reporters have been appointed to deal with ‘CPO No. 2’, as well as with the previous CPO and other Orders, at the inquiry. I have written separately to those who have objected to CPO No. 2, advising them of the relevant procedures.

Finally, paragraphs 25 and 26 of the note deal with the structure and programming of the inquiry. In the light of information presently available, the reporters consider that it would probably be appropriate to hear evidence in the following order: the scheme as a whole, then the Fastlink, then the Southern Leg, and then the Northern Leg.
