This statement of case is presented by me personally as owner land at Blaikiewell, Maryculter on which draft Compulsory Purchase Orders and Side Road Orders have been served.

As a statutory objector to the above, I wish to present evidence for consideration at the forthcoming public local inquiry. My previous letters of objection and my recent letters of 3 May 2008 to Mr Bell, DPEA and of 14 May 2008 to Mr Buchan, AWPR Assistant Managing Agent, provide further details.

I intend to present evidence to show that:-

1. My livery business and riding school will be affected by the proposals
2. My animal sanctuary will be affected by the proposals
3. The scheme will have a major affect on the environment of the area.

The areas to be covered include:-

1. The livery business
2. The riding school
3. The environmental issues at Blaikiewell
4. The potential AWPR route impact
5. Objections re specific Compulsory Purchase Orders and Side Road Orders.

A witness may lead evidence on the environment, archaeology and ecology

Although my land with is subject to CPO is both on the Fastlink and Southern Leg, I think it would be appropriate to present evidence in the Southern Leg section.
