**1. Introduction**

- 1.1. Mr and Mrs Robertson are proprietors of land at Logie and Westport Farms, Cowie, Stonehaven.
- 1.2. Both are statutory objectors to The A90 (Aberdeen Western Peripheral Route) Special Road and The A956 (Aberdeen Western Peripheral Route) Special Road Compulsory Purchase Order 200[ ].
- 1.3. They are affected by the proposed acquisition of Plot Numbers 3604, 3605, and 5602.

**2. The Objections**

- 2.1. Mr and Mrs Robertson are supportive of the promoters' proposals for the construction of the Fastlink section of the AWPR.
- 2.2. It has been brought to the objectors' attention that the Sluie Estate Trust is likely to be propose to the Inquiry an alternative configuration for the Stonehaven Junction. To date, insufficient information has been provided to the objectors to allow reasoned consideration of any alternative proposal and they therefore maintain objection to any alternative layout pending provision of full details.

**3. Evidence and Witnesses**

- 3.1. The objectors will wish to participate in those sessions of the Inquiry dealing with alternatives to the proposed Stonehaven Junction.
- 3.2. Pending provision of information by other parties, the right is reserved for Mr D Robertson and / or Mrs E Robertson to present evidence.
- 3.3. Pending provision of information by other parties, additional witnesses may be called in response to such information.
